Screening Questions

Meeting with Parents

Introduce yourself and have the parents introduce themselves and their child

Review Developmental Screening

- 1. Review results of DIAL-4 Developmental Screening (EC may assist)
- 2. Sign any paperwork needed for referrals
 - a. Release of Information
- 3. Inform parents that progress reports will be completed throughout the year to update them on their how their child is doing and to get input on what they want their child to work on.
- 4. Ask the parents if they have any concerns for their child and what their goals are for their child

Paperwork and Home Visits

- 1. Have parents review information on their emergency cards. Spelling of names, address, phone number, child care, emergency contacts, etc.
- 2. Set up initial home visit for prior to school starting
- 3. Ask for directions to their home
- 4. Give a reminder card with date/time of home visit
